## **WEIGHTING-IN, MEDICAL CHECK and MEDICAL SERVICES**

Registration and weighting-in of the fighter will be made after presenting the following documents:

- WAKO sport pass for WAKO members.
- Passport or ID-card for others (non members). Please note that a 15 EUR fee applies for NON-members of WAKO.
- Valid permit to fight signed by a sports doctor.
- Health insurance
- All participants must take visas in Estonian embassies in their countries, if needed
- 35 EUR in cash for the starting fee (50 EUR FOR NON WAKO MEMBERS)

ATTENTION	If sportsmen do not have a medical permit, examination on the spot costs <b>15 EUR</b> .
ATTENTION	ZERO TOLERANCE DURING THE WEIGHT-IN, each fighter must correspond to his registered weight.
MEDICAL SERVICES	Organizer is responsible for providing medical help to all official members of participating teams during the competition (according to their health-insurance).

After the 6th of DECEMBER registration will be CLOSED and NO new forms will be accepted!

**Starting fee is 35 EUR** per competitor (50 EUR for non-members of WAKO). Payment must be made during the registration in cash.

If you are bringing a Judge/Referee to the tournament, please notify the Chief Referee. Without notification, he/she won't get paid. All payment will be done according to the rates of Estonian Kickboxing Federation.

#### **PROTECTION AND EQUIPMENT FOR K-1**

- Boxing gloves, 10 OZ, without laces
- Head-protection (top of the head must be covered), according to the color of the corner. Classic boxing helmets are forbidden.
- Mouth guard (for male and female mandatory).
- Groin protection for male and female (breast protection for female).
- Boxing wraps.
- Kickboxing Shorts (MUAY-THAI symbolic is NOT ALLOWED!).
- Shin guards (please look at the pictures below to check the allowed shin guards).
   Shin guards with metal/plastic elements and SOCKS-TYPE are forbidden!

#### **RULES and PROTESTS**

Competition is held under amateur WAKO rules, which can be found on <a href="https://wako.sport/rules/">https://wako.sport/rules/</a>

Protest during the competition is only accepted if announced by competitors Coach or their representative immediately after the fight and after submitting an official WAKO protest form to the name of Chief referee with a pledge of 100 EUR no later than 10 minutes after the fight. Final decision will be given by the members of the appeal committee.

#### **MEDALS AND AWARDING**

1st, 2nd and 3rd places will get medals and diplomas. Fighters with the best techniques and showing the will to win will be awarded with special prizes. The top 3 teams will be honored with special awards (team standings).m

## **VISA INFORMATION**

All participants must take visas in Estonian embassies in their countries if needed. Estonia is a member of the European Union and part of Schengen territory.
